- 27** Jillian has a rowing machine. The table below lists the number of calories she burns when she exercises on her rowing machine.

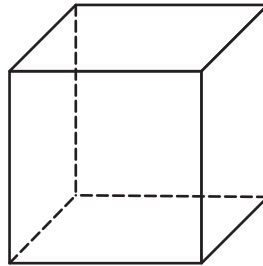
**Calories Burned
